HILLCO Statement of Limited Warranty

Class III Warranty

Hillco warrants its Class III products to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of twelve (12) consecutive months following the warranty start date.

The warranty start date for Hillco Class III products is the date of the invoice, or the first date of use. whichever is earliest. Once the warranty period has begun, it cannot be stopped or interrupted.

Hillco warrants genuine Hillco replacement parts and components to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of ninety (90) consecutive days following the Hillco invoice date, or the remainder of the original equipment warranty period, whichever is longer.

Hillco's obligation under this parts warranty shall be limited to repairing or replacing, any part(s) that, in Hillco's judgment, shows evidence of such defect, to the original purchaser. This parts warranty does not cover any related labor associated with replacing parts deemed to be defective.

Limitations to Warranty

This warranty does not cover:

- 1) Any product damaged by accident, abuse, misuse, negligence, or improper maintenance.
- 2) Any unauthorized product alteration or modification.
- 3) Any unauthorized repairs made with parts other than genuine Hillco parts unless specifically authorized by Hillco.
- 4) Any repairs performed by anyone other than Hillco or an authorized Hillco dealer unless specifically authorized by Hillco.
- 5) Any claims directly resulting from improper installation, except those installations performed by Hillco.
- 6) Any labor costs associated with the defective part(s).

Warranty Procedure

Hillco Class III Warranty Registration Card must be completed and submitted by retail customer within thirty (30) days of purchase.

All warranty work must be performed, and claims submitted, within thirty (30) days of the occurrence of the claim and within the warranty period.

All parts removed during warranty repair should be held for a period of sixty (60) days after the warranty claim has been submitted to Hillco.

Hillco reserves the right to either inspect the product at the original retail purchaser's location, or the authorized Hillco's dealer's location; or require it to be returned to Hillco, transportation charges prepaid, for inspection.

- Proof of purchase
- Description of issue
- Serial number and/or part number(s) of items needing replaced, and
- If available, include any photos that can assist to describe the issue.


Limitation of Liability


Hillco reserves the right to make improvements in design or changes in specifications at any time, without incurring any obligation to owners of units previously sold.



Remove the original plastic air intake tube by removing the bolts that secure the intake to the cab (A). Discard fasteners.

Loosen the clamp at the bottom of the air intake tube. The clamp will be reused.









Remove the 3 bolts that secure the bottom of the are intake to the mount.

Remove plastic air intake tube.




Remove the air intake mounts (C) from the handrail mounts. The mounts may be froze to the isolators. Use a prybar to remove the mount. The isolator and other fasteners will be reused.


Note: Do not grab onto the handrail as it is not secured.




Secure the bottom mount (A) to the original mount using the two M10 x 30 bolts. Do not tighten at this time. The rubber elbow will sit on this mount.





Install the adapter (B) to the elbow (C) with the notched end to the clamp. Install a clamp around the elbow and tighten. The bottom of the rib has been notched to not interfere with the cradle.



Install the elbow to the tractor. Insert the adapter (B) into the original intake tube (D) and set the elbow on the bottom mount (A).












Replace the M10 X 40 bolts (A) on the handle bar bracket with M10 X 50 bolts (B).


Discard M10 X 40 Bolts. Remove the rubber isolators.


Install the 3/4 inch ID washers (C) over isolators (D) and then insert the isolators into the holes in the hillco intake tube. Do this for all 4 isolators. See below diagram

The washers will take up space so that when the Hillco Airflow system is installed it is tightly secured to the handrail mounts.

Install the intake tube into the bottom boot. Then align the four mounting holes on the intake tube to the front side of the four handrail mounting bolts as shown. See pictures on the following page.










This is a view from the back side of the mounts.

- B Original Bolts and Washers
- C Cab Mounts
- D Handrail
- E Rubber Isolator
- F Hillco 3/4 inch ID Washer
- G Hillco Intake Mount




Secure the intake mounts with the original washers and nuts. Tighten to prevailing torque.



Make sure the rubber elbow (H) is overlapping the intake tube (I) by at least 1".

Tighten the clamp. Tighten the bolts on the bottom support (J).

It may be necessary to trim part of the top of the rubber boot if it does not fit properly between the intake tube and the bottom support (J).



Install the pre-cleaner to the intake tube. Press the intake all the way down onto the tube. Make sure that the slits in the pre-cleaner are covered so that all air entering has to go through the pre-cleaner.






Locate the discharge louver on the side of the pre-cleaner. Rotate the pre-cleaner on the intake tube so that the discharge louver is point to the outside of the tractor.

Secure pre-cleaner to intake with the provided 8" clamp. Tighten to 7.5 ft/lbs (90 in. lbs or 1.0369 kg-m)

For maximum performance with your Hillco Air Flow System, install a new air filter element, check air intake system for leaks or damage and repair as necessary.



This completes the install.
